The 2009-2010 Odyssey of the Mind Season is just beginning, and we hope that you'll join us for another season of creative problem solving. It's been a nice restful summer, but now is the time to pull your teams together, and have them put on their thinking caps as they tackle this year's Long Term Problems (see reverse of this sheet).

Not a lot has changed this season – the national membership fee is still \$135 (which still covers 1 team per LT Problem per Division) and the Vermont State Tournament fee is still \$40 per team (\$10 for Primary teams), which means Odyssey of the Mind has a very low cost per participant compared to other student enrichment activities. Our all-volunteer Board of Directors knows that cost is an important factor, and works hard to keep expenses low.

We have expanded our Coaches Training opportunities this year. Check out the full Coaches Training and Program Schedule on our website. More trainings may be offered as necessary. The 31st Vermont Odyssey of the Mind State Tournament will be held on Saturday, March 6th, at Champlain Valley Union High School in Hinesburg, Vermont.
